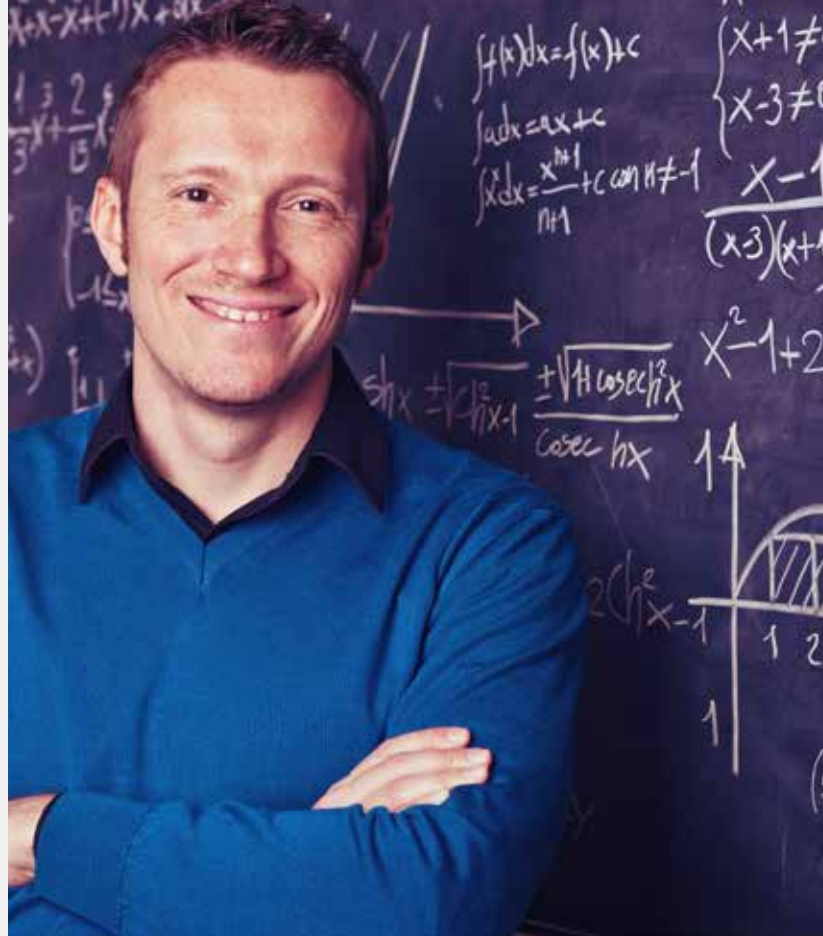


# Course Overview

To achieve the qualification, there is a requirement for teaching practice that requires observation and assessment of performance.

- Action Learning to Support Development of Subject Specific Pedagogy

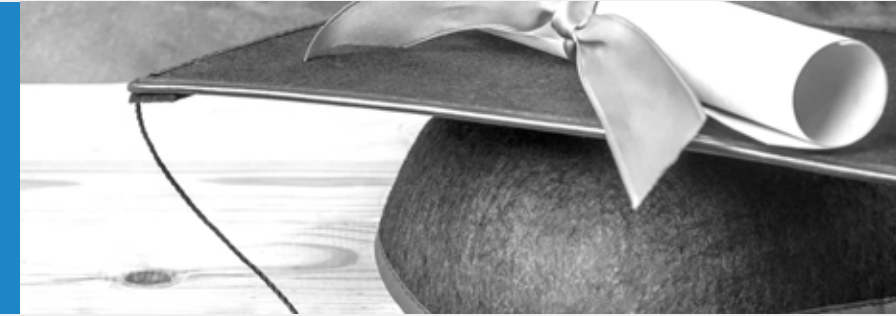
# Intended Learning Outcome

- Be able to promote positive behaviour

- Ability to learn reflectively, develop skills and understand the limits of own knowledge
- Ability to complete investigations and effectively communicate results

# Teaching & Learning



All units are delivered using a diverse range of teacher training course and learning methods that support independent student learning. These include informal lectures, online teaching materials and research activities. Learners are encouraged to engage with learning through discussions, role plays, feedback team presentations and Q and A sessions and educational tours.

## Assessment

Students will be assessed using centre devised Written Assignments, Portfolio Building, Self and Peer Assessments, as well as Presentations including Group Presentations.

The overall grade for the qualification is a 'pass'. The learner must achieve all the required units as indicated in the specified teaching qualification structure.

To pass a unit the learner must:

- achieve all the specified learning outcomes
- satisfy all the assessment criteria by providing sufficient and valid evidence for each criterion
- show that the evidence is their own.

The general approach to the learning process for most modules involves:

- Lectures
- Tutorials
- Case studies
- Class discussions
- Presentations
