Can you tell us a few words about your business?

My name is Ken Orlukwu and I am the founder of an online business directory - wetindey.co.uk. It is currently running as a web portal listing

and advertsing the best and trendiest African restaurants to launch an app in the 1st quarter of 2019 and expand the listings to other cities outside London. Due to the nature of the business, it is currently trading remotely, but with plans to acquire an office in South or East London for easy access for potential client (restaurateurs and event organisers) visit.

The platform is open to all phone, tablet and PC users, as it is very user-friendly, which will enable the visitor to use the website to sign up (username and email) to get more updates. Once signed up, they will receive an introductory e-Voucher to use in some of our partner restaurants, and also be informed first hand on meal

deals, discounts and other offers. The target market is for between 20 - 50 years and will also target tourist visiting London for the first time.

Did you start studying at MRC before or after you have started your business?

I have been working on the platform for over a year before joining MRC, however I launched it after I started my Hospitality course in MRC.

Has the course you are studying helped you with your business? If so, please tell us how.

Studying the hospitality course has helped broaden my knowledge and scope of improving the platform.
